**Sub: Matter related to representation dated 12/11/2021 from Ratnadeep Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Jamkhed Homoeopathic Medical College, Jamkhed (Ratnapur), Tal. Jamkhed, Dist., Ahmednagar-413201, Maharashtra for continuing admission in (I<sup>st</sup> BHMS) course with intake capacity of 100 seats for the academic session 2021-22-reg.**

Sir/Madam,

This has reference to your representation dated 12/11/2021 to the Commission against the denial letter passed by Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MA&RB) vide its letter dated 02/12/2021. The submission made through representation dated 12/11/2021 to consider the required documents/information pointed out while granting the permission for student intake of 60 seats instead of 100 seats in I-BHMS course for the academic session 2021-22 has been carefully examined by the Commission and observed the following:

**1. Submission of College to Commission:**

*Observations of Hearing Committee & MA&RB vide letter dated 02/12/2021 mentioned that Teaching Faculty: Dr. Sanjay Kumar S. Zine (Reader, Obstetrics/ Gynaecology) and Ajay H. Rokade (Lecturer, Obstetrics/ Gynaecology); Signature in Affidavit are not matching with Teachers code documents.*

College has submitted affidavit signed in front of Advocate & Notary Public and approval from MUHS vide letter No. MUHS/(UG)/E4/Jamkhed/2515/2019 dated 21/9/2019 regarding signature of the teachers. Copy of joining letter with signature is also submitted.

**Observation:**

Commission examined the documents and observed that the affidavit signed before Advocate & Notary Public regarding mismatch of signature teacher(s) found acceptable. Therefore, the Commission agreed to exclude this point.

**2. Submission of College to Commission:**

*Observations of Hearing Committee & MA&RB vide letter dated 02/12/2021 mentioned that the Guest faculty not eligible as previous teaching experience not specified, stated as Professional experience*

College has submitted the list of 12 Guest Faculty and their affidavits along with relevant documents already submitted along with CCH Part-I as per HCC MSR-2013.

**Observation:**

Commission examined the experience certificate/affidavit for 12 Guest Faculty and observed that the professional certificate for the teachers is not acceptable. As per the Schedule VII of MSR, 2013 for the post of Professor/Assistant Professor/Reader, the teaching experience should be in the concerned subject. Therefore, the irregularity persists.

**3. Submission of College to Commission:**

*Observations of Hearing Committee & MA&RB vide letter dated 02/12/2021 mentioned that No supportive documents provided for salary bank statement and EPF/PF deduction. Acquaintance Roll provided for January 2021 and April 2021 but no salary transactions details provided.*

College has submitted the copies of Form No. 16 submitted along with CCH Part I, Acquaintance roll of staff, list of EPF Number of staff registered.

**Observation:**

Commission examined the copy of Acquaintance roll for staff, Form No. 16, the list of EPF and number of registered staff and observed that the Bank statement and copy of each challan receipt from concerned Department are to be verified. However, College has submitted Form 16. Hence the point does not exist.

**4. Submission of College to Commission:**

*Observations of Hearing Committee & MA&RB vide letter dated 02/12/2021 mentioned that attendance provided for month of January 2021 and April 2021 only, instead of Calendar year 2019 and 2020 as required in the Part I.*

Govt. of Maharashtra had directed for stopping Biometric attendance vide Govt. GR No.SMY-2020/P.K.31/18(R.V.K.) Dated 16/03/2021 due to COVID-19 Pandemic situation. College has submitted a copy of the letter. Copy of the attendance sheet (submitted along with CCH Part-I ) is also submitted.


**Observation:**

College has informed that the Govt. of Maharashtra had directed vide Govt. GR No.SMY-2020/P.K.31/18 (R.V.K.) dated 16/03/2020 for stopping biometric attendance for the institutions due to COVID-19 Pandemic situation. However, the College could not submit attendance for 2019& 2020. Therefore, the deficiency is persisting.

**Overall observations:**

1. Based on the submission made by Ratnadeep Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Jamkhed Homoeopathic Medical College, Jamkhed (Ratnapur), Tal. Jamkhed, Dist., Ahmednagar, the Commission have been carefully examined the documents as per the provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals ) regulations, 2013 and the relevant regulations made there under and it is observed that the regular faculty for the College are fulfilling the eligibility, whereas guest faculty is not eligible.
2. Therefore, Commission decided to grant permission for reduced seats from 100 to 90 for A.Y. 2021-22 in Ratnadeep Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Jamkhed Homoeopathic Medical College, Jamkhed (Ratnapur), Tal. Jamkhed, Dist., Ahmednagar-413201, Maharashtra.
3. College should appoint eligible Guest Faculty within one month and send compliance report immediately thereafter to Commission. Accordingly, your representation dated 28/03/2021 received to Commission against MA&RB letter dated 02/12/2021 stands disposed off.


